

**ORDINANCE 58-2006**

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$71,555.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO REPLACE THE 911 SYSTEM FOR THE MADISON POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$71,555.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to replace the 911 system with a Zetron E911 PSAP telephone system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$71,555.00 for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$71,555.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to replace the 911 system with a Zetron E911 PSAP telephone system.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The amount of \$71,555.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund to replace the 911 system with a Zetron E911 PSAP telephone system.

**SECTION 2:** The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
