

**ORDINANCE 25-2005**

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$7,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO HAND HELD LASER RADAR UNITS FOR THE MADISON POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Administrator has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$7,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of two hand held laser radar units for the Madison Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$7,000.00 for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$7,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of two hand held laser radar units for the Madison Police Department; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The amount of \$7,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of two hand held laser radar units for the Madison Police Department.

**SECTION 2:** The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
