

ORDINANCE 5-2004

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING SECTION 185-29 OF THE BOROUGH CODE TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON BOTH SIDES OF PARK AVENUE FROM ELM STREET TO CEDAR AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommend there be no parking on both sides of Park Avenue from a point opposite the southerly side of Elm Street, northerly to a point opposite the north side of Cedar Avenue (east side of Park Avenue) and from the southerly side of Elm Street northerly to the Northern side of Cedar Street (west side of Park Avenue); and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that Chapter 185 of the Madison Borough Code entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" should be amended in order to implement this change.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: Section 185-29 of the Code of the Borough of Madison entitled "Schedule I: No Parking", is hereby amended to include the following:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Sides</u>	<u>Location</u>
Park Avenue	East	From a point opposite the southerly side of Elm Street northerly to a point opposite the north side of Cedar Avenue
Park Avenue	West	From the southerly side of Elm Street northerly to the Northern side of Cedar Avenue

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
