

**ORDINANCE 6- 2004**

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$27,500.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES IN REGARD TO THE MADISON FREE PUBLIC LIBRARY**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Administrator has recommended \$27,500.00 be appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for professional architectural services provided by James Goldstein, AIA, in regard to the Madison Free Public Library; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$27,500.00 for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$27,500.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purpose as described herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The amount of \$27,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for professional architectural services as described herein.

**SECTION 2:** The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law
