

**ORDINANCE 28-2004**

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING ORDINANCE 46-2003 PERTAINING TO PART-TIME NON-UNION SALARIES AND OFFICES TO PROVIDE FOR THE POSITION OF A PART TIME CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL**

**WHEREAS**, the Construction Code Official has recommended that Ordinance 46-2003 be amended to provide for the position of a part time Code Enforcement Official at a salary range of \$25,000.00 to \$35,000.00;and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council agrees with such recommendation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Ordinance 46-2003 pertaining to part-time non-union salaries and offices is hereby amended to reflect the salary range of Code Enforcement Official as follows:

<b>POSITION</b>	<b>MINIMUM</b>	<b>MAXIMUM</b>
Code Enforcement Official	\$25,000	\$35,000

**SECTION 2:** This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
