

ORDINANCE 31-2004

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING CHAPTER 134 OF THE BOROUGH CODE TO PROVIDE FOR THE SALE OF COMMUTER NON-RESIDENT PARKING PERMITS

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that Chapter 134 of the Madison Borough Code entitled "Parking Lots" should be amended to provide for the sale of commuter non-resident parking permits; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined to modify the Madison Borough Code, Chapter 134 in such a manner as to determine fees and certain terms and conditions in regard to the sale of commuter non-resident parking permits and provide for annual revisions of the fees thereafter by resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 134-1 of the Borough Code entitled "Definitions; interpretation of terms" is hereby amended to include the following definition:

COMMUTER NON-RESIDENT VEHICLES -- Those vehicles owned by a non-resident of the borough but not an owner or employee of a commercial establishment of the borough. Parking for non-resident vehicles is limited to Kings Road Lot 2 and Kings Road Lot 3.

SECTION 2: Section 134-6H of the Borough Code shall be amended to read as follows:

H. Kings Road Lot No. 2. Parking hours and limitations are designated as follows:

(1) Monday through Friday, residents' vehicles and non-residents' vehicles as defined in Subsection H(2) below, and commercial vehicles as defined in Subsections C(1), D(1) and G(4) may be parked for periods of not more than 12 hours, commencing at 12:01 a.m. on those days.

(2) Residents' vehicles; vehicles owned by a resident of the borough. Non-residents' vehicles; vehicles owned by a non-resident of the borough. All vehicles, including

commercial vehicles, must display a parking permit in the rear window, driver's side. The parking permit shall be obtained pursuant to § 134-10.

(3) On Saturday and Sunday, the lot may be used by the general public.

SECTION 3: Section 134-6I(1) of the Borough Code shall be amended to read as follows:

(1) Unnumbered spaces. Monday through Friday, commuter residents' vehicles, commuter non-residents' vehicles and merchant permit vehicles may be parked for periods of not more than 12 hours, commencing at 12:01 AM on those days, provided that said vehicles must display a parking permit in the rear window, driver's side. The parking permit shall be obtained pursuant to §134-10.

SECTION 4: Section 134-10B(2) of the Borough Code shall be amended to include the following subparagraph (d):

(d) Non-Resident Commuter (Commuter Non-Residents' Vehicles) -\$750 per year.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
