

ORDINANCE 32-2004

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$10,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR RELOCATION OF ANTENNA CABLES AT THE MIDWOOD TERRACE WATER TOWER

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$10,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the relocation of the radio antenna cables for the Fire Department, Department of Public Works and Ambulance Squad at the Midwood Terrace water tower; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$10,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the relocation of the radio antenna cables for the Fire Department, Department of Public Works and Ambulance Squad at the Midwood Terrace water tower; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the relocation of the radio antenna cables for the Fire Department, Department of Public Works and Ambulance Squad at the Midwood Terrace water tower.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
