

**ORDINANCE 33-2004**

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$155,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE MADISON BIKE PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Engineer has recommended the Borough appropriate \$155,000.00 for the Madison Bike plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$155,000.00 for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$155,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the Madison Bike plan based on a grant from the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The amount of \$155,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the Madison Bike Plan.

**SECTION 2:** The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
