

ORDINANCE 22-2004

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$52,200.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Madison Police Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$52,200.00 to fund laptops, live scan and bar coding projects for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$52,200.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$52,200.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to fund laptops, live scan and bar coding projects for the Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$52,200.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund to fund laptops, live scan and bar coding projects for the Police Department.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
