

ORDINANCE 53-2004

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$22,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT UPGRADE OF SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS

WHEREAS, the Borough Fire Chief has recommended the Borough appropriate \$22,000.00 to upgrade the Fire Department's self-contained breathing apparatus air packs, to include an upgrade of the regulator, frame, pressure reducer, and rapid intervention connection in order to meet the revised National Fire Protection Agency (NFPA) standard 1981; and

WHEREAS, this upgrade is the second year of a three year phase in to gain compliance with the NFPA standards; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$22,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$22,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to upgrade the Fire Department's self-contained breathing apparatus air packs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$22,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund to upgrade the Fire Department's self-contained breathing apparatus air packs.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
