

ORDINANCE 8-2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING THE LIST OF HANDICAPPED SPACES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 110 OF THE MADISON BOROUGH CODE TO DESIGNATE ONE HANDICAPPED SPACE ON WAVERLY PLACE

WHEREAS, the Borough Chief of Police has recommended that the first parking space on the westerly side of the southbound lane of Waverly Place, being the closest parking space to the intersection of Waverly Place and Main Street, be designated as handicapped parking pursuant to Chapter 110-1 of the Madison Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 110B1 of the Madison Borough Code, designates handicapped parking spaces as set forth on a list, a copy of which list is on file in the Borough Clerk's Office and which list the Chief of Police recommends be amended to include the above described parking space on the westerly side of the southbound lane of Waverly Place; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council agrees with this recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 110-1 of the Borough Code is amended to provide that the list of handicapped spaces on file with the Borough Clerk's Office shall include one space designated as handicapped parking on the westerly side of the southbound lane of Waverly Place, which space is the closest to the intersection of Waverly Place and Main Street.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
