

ORDINANCE 14-2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$860,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR 2003 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO KINGS ROAD, BRITTIN STREET, GROVE STREET, HIGHLAND AVENUE AND BELLEAU AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$860,000.00 for the 2003 Road Improvement Program which involves milling, overlay, reconstruction, sidewalk and curb replacement, to Kings Road, Brittin Street, Grove Street, Highland Avenue and Belleau Avenue, with a bid alternate for upgrades to Kings Road water main; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$860,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$860,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the 2003 road improvement program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$860,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the 2003 Road Improvement Program, which involves milling, overlay, reconstruction, sidewalk and curb replacement, to Kings Road, Brittin Street, Grove Street, Highland Avenue and Belleau Avenue, with a bid alternate for upgrades to Kings Road water main.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
