

## ORDINANCE 17-2003

### **ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$21,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE UPGRADE OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS**

**WHEREAS**, the National Fire Protection Agency (NFPA) has recently revised standard 1981, the regulation for breathing apparatus; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Fire Chief has certified the Fire Department's self-contained breathing apparatus air packs are not up to the revised standard; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Fire Chief has recommended the Borough appropriate \$21,000.00 to upgrade the Fire Department's self-contained breathing apparatus air packs, to include an upgrade of the regulator, frame, pressure reducer, and rapid intervention connection in order to meet the revised NFPA standard; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$21,000.00 for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$21,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to upgrade the Fire Department's self-contained breathing apparatus air packs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The amount of \$21,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund to upgrade the Fire Department's self-contained breathing apparatus air packs.

**SECTION 2:** The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
