

ORDINANCE 5 - 2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$10,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR ADDITIONAL COST OF LIGHTING UPGRADE FOR DODGE FIELD

WHEREAS, Ordinance 31-2001 of the Borough of Madison appropriated \$45,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the lighting upgrade at Dodge Field; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bid received for project entitled "Dodge Field Lighting Addition" was in the amount of \$48,800.00, submitted by Fai-Gon Electric, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough appropriate an additional \$10,000.00 in addition to the \$45,000.00 appropriated by Ordinance 31-2001, totaling \$55,000.00 to cover the cost of the lighting upgrade for Dodge Field and some additional conduit changes; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate an additional \$10,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to add to the \$45,000.00 previously appropriated by Ordinance 31-2001 for the lighting upgrade at Dodge Field; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the lighting upgrade at Dodge Field.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law
