

**ORDINANCE 22-2003**

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$4,500.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE TO UPGRADE TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT ALARM BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, the Police Chief has recommended the Borough appropriate \$4,500.00 for the purchase and installation of hardware and software to digitize the Police Department alarm board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$4,500.00 for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate these funds for this purpose.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The amount of \$4,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase and installation of hardware and software to digitize the Police Department alarm board.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
