

ORDINANCE 44-2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$130,000 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR RENOVATION OF THE SECOND FLOOR OF THE MADISON CIVIC CENTER

WHEREAS, funding is required to continue renovation of the Madison Civic Center, 28 Walnut Street; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$130,000.00 for the renovation of the second floor of the Civic Center building; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$130,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$130,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement for the renovations described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$130,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the renovation of the second floor of the Civic Center building.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
