

ORDINANCE 45-2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$5,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF RADIO, EMERGENCY LIGHTS AND MARKINGS FOR THE NEW PICK-UP TRUCK FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Ordinance 16-2003 of the Borough of Madison appropriated \$25,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase a pick-up truck to replace the 15 year old truck #5 which is used daily in the Fire Department as an inspectors vehicle and is scheduled for replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Madison Fire Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$5,000.00 to purchase radios, emergency lights and markings for the new truck; and

WHEREAS, Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$5,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of radios, emergency lights and markings for the replacement pick-up truck #5 for the Fire Department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$5,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of radios, emergency lights and markings for the replacement pick-up truck for the Fire Department.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
