

ORDINANCE 50 - 2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$1,400,000.00 FROM THE WATER UTILITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR AWARD OF THE PROJECT ENTITLED "WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS – WELL D VOC REMOVAL FACILITY"

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended \$1,400,000.00 be appropriated from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund for the award of the project entitled "Water System Improvements – Well D VOC Removal Facility", which involves bringing Well D into operational service after many years of inactivity; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$1,400,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$1,400,000.00 from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund for the purpose as described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$1,400,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund for the award of the project entitled "Water System Improvements – Well D VOC Removal Facility", as described herein.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law
