

**ORDINANCE 53 - 2003**

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$46,600.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT FOR THE MAIN STREET SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Engineer has recommended \$46,600.00 be appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for professional engineering services to plan and design final construction documents for the Main Street sidewalk improvement project in the Borough of Madison; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$46,600.00 for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$46,600.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purpose as described herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The amount of \$46,600.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for professional engineering services as described herein.

**SECTION 2:** The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.
