

ORDINANCE 54-2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING SECTION 112-3 OF BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION" TO REFLECT THE LENGTH OF MEMBERS' TERMS

WHEREAS, the Borough Administrator has recommended revisions to the Madison Borough Code, more specifically, Section 112-3 entitled "Historic Preservation Commission" in order to reflect the term lengths of Historic Preservation Commission Members to comply with N.J.S.A. 40:55D-107; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council agrees with this recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 112-3, of the Borough Code entitled "Historic Preservation Commission" is amended to read as follows

§112-3. Historic Preservation Commission.

...

B. Establishment.

...

(2) Terms:

(a) There shall be no change in the term of office of those members serving on the Commission at the time this chapter becomes effective. Thereafter, the term of a regular member shall be four years; the term of an alternate member shall be two years.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
