

ORDINANCE 55- 2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$95,000.00 FROM THE WATER UTILITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR CONSTRUCTION REVIEW AND INSPECTION FOR THE BOROUGH'S WELL D VOLATILE ORGANIC CHEMICAL TREATMENT FACILITY

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended \$95,000.00 be appropriated from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund for professional engineering services for construction review and onsite inspection for the Borough's Well D Volatile Organic Chemical ("VOC") treatment facility to assure the facility construction complies with the approved plans and specifications and is constructed in accordance with important construction deadlines; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$95,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$95,000.00 from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund for the purpose as described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$95,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund for professional engineering services as described herein.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law
