

ORDINANCE 14-2002

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$50,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR CIVIC CENTER PROJECTS

WHEREAS, funding is required to continue renovation of the Madison Civic Center, 28 Walnut Street, to expand its usefulness to the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$50,000.00 for the conversion of 1,900 square feet of unoccupied business office space to assembly space for government, educational or non-profit use, including necessary architectural services and handicap accessibility to the senior center; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$50,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement for the improvements described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$50,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the conversion of 1,900 square feet of unoccupied business office space to assembly space for government, educational or non-profit uses, including necessary architectural services and handicap accessibility to the senior center.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
