

ORDINANCE 19-2002

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$125,000.00 FROM THE WATER UTILITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR WATERLINE REPLACEMENT AT WALNUT STREET

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended waterline replacement at Walnut Street; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$125,000.00 from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund for waterline replacement at Walnut Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$125,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund for waterline replacement at Walnut Street.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
