

ORDINANCE 07-2002

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$500,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE 2002 ROAD PROGRAM IMPROVEMENTS TO REDMOND DRIVE, ROSEMONT AVENUE, ARDSLEIGH DRIVE, CEDAR STREET AND DEHART PLACE

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough construct new curbs, sidewalks, drainage, milling and overlay of Redmond, Rosemont, Ardsleigh, Cedar and Dehart streets; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$500,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to construct new curbs, sidewalks, drainage, milling and overlay of Redmond, Rosemont, Ardsleigh, Cedar and Dehart streets; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$500,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund to construct new curbs, sidewalks, drainage, milling and overlay of Redmond, Rosemont, Ardsleigh, Cedar and Dehart streets.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
