

ORDINANCE 34-2002

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$7,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO REPAIR SIDEWALKS, RESET FRONT STEPS, ADD HANDRAIL TO THE FRONT ENTRANCE, AND TO MODIFY THE HVAC SYSTEM AT THE MUSEUM OF EARLY TRADES AND CRAFTS

WHEREAS, the Director Board of the Museum of Early Trades and Crafts has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$7,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements to the Museum of Early Trades and Crafts: repair sidewalks, reset the front steps, add handrail to the front entrance and modify the HVAC system; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$7,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$7,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for said improvements to the Museum of Early Trades and Crafts; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$7,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements to the building and property occupied by the Museum of Early Trades and Crafts: repair sidewalks, reset the front steps, add handrail to the front entrance and modify the HVAC system.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
