

ORDINANCE 36-2002

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$40,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR CEILING WORK IN THE ADULT SERVICES DEPARTMENT, UPGRADE OF SECURITY AND FIRE SYSTEMS, ADA WORK ON THE FRONT DOOR, NEW LIGHTING IN CHILDREN'S SERVICES STACKS AND AN EXTERIOR SIGN FOR ADVERTISING LIBRARY HOURS AT THE MADISON PUBLIC LIBRARY

WHEREAS, the Director of the Madison Public Library has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$40,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements to the Madison Public Library: ceiling work in the Adult Services Department, upgrade of security and fire systems, Americans with Disabilities Act (hereinafter "ADA") work on the front door, new lighting in Children's Services stacks and an exterior sign for advertising library hours; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$40,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for said improvements to the Madison Public Library; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$40,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements to the Madison Public Library: ceiling work in the Adult Services Department, upgrade of security and fire systems, ADA work on the front door, new lighting in Children's Services stacks and an exterior sign for advertising library hours.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
