

ORDINANCE 38-2002

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$28,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR MAIN STREET TREE PROJECT

WHEREAS, Council Member Mary-Anna Holden, on behalf of the Shade Tree Management Board, has recommended that the Borough proceed with the Main Street Tree Project, which includes, saw cutting and demolition of existing sidewalks in tree well areas, removal and disposal of existing soil, backfill and preparation of the soil, installation of temporary surface purchase and planting of trees along Main Street; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$28,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$28,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the Main Street Tree Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$28,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the Main Street Tree Project.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
