

1 ORDINANCE 35-2009

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$12,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR DRAINAGE REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE MUSEUM OF EARLY TRADES & CRAFTS

WHEREAS, the Borough Administrator has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$12,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for drainage repairs and improvements to the Museum of Early Trades & Crafts; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$12,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$12,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for drainage repairs and improvements to the Museum of Early Trades & Crafts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$12,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for drainage repairs and improvements to the Museum of Early Trades & Crafts.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
