

ORDINANCE 41-2015

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$5,740.00 FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TRUST FUND TO PURCHASE HYDRANT FLAGS

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$5,740.00 from the Fire Department Trust Fund to purchase 700 hydrant flags; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of the funds in the Fire Trust Fund in an amount not to exceed \$5,740.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$5,740.00 from the Fire Trust Fund to purchase 700 hydrant flags; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$5,740.00 is hereby appropriated from the Fire Department Trust Fund to purchase 700 hydrant flags.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
