

ORDINANCE 29-2016

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON  
APPROPRIATING \$15,000.00 FROM GENERAL CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE  
ANTENNA FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT RADIO AT THE  
MIDWOOD WATER TANK

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$15,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to replace the antenna and coax for the Fire Department radio transmitter at the Midwood water tank ; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$15,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to replace the antenna and coax for the Fire Department radio transmitter at the Midwood water tank.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$15,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund to replace the antenna and coax for the Fire Department radio transmitter at the Midwood water tank.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
