

ORDINANCE 40-2016

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$52,000.00  
FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF A  
POLICE VEHICLE AND ACCESSORIES

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$52,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a police vehicle and accessories; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$52,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, this expenditure was reviewed as part of the 2016 Capital Budget and the Borough Council has determined that \$52,000.00 should be appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a police vehicle and accessories.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$52,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a police vehicle and accessories.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
