

ORDINANCE 19-2011

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING CHAPTER 147 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "FEES"

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended that the fees for fingerprinting for fire arms, real estate, etc., be amended; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that there is a need to approve such increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that Section 147-1 of the Borough Code entitled "Fees for copies of particular records and documents" shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 1:

§ 147-1 Fees for copies of particular records and documents.

....

C. Police records.

(7) Fingerprinting for firearms, real estate, etc.: \$20 per card.

....

SECTION 2: All other provisions of the Ordinance not inconsistent herewith shall remain the same.
