

ORDINANCE 22-2010

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING SECTION 56-4 OF THE BOROUGH CODE TO INCREASE ANNUAL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE FEES

WHEREAS, the Borough Clerk has recommended that the fees for licenses to sell alcoholic beverages be increased; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that there is a need to approve such increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 56 of the Borough Code entitled "Alcoholic Beverages" shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 1:

§ 56-4 Fees established.

Annual fees for licenses to sell alcoholic beverages in the Borough of Madison, beginning July 1, 2010, shall be as follows:

A. Plenary retail consumption license:

Period	Fee
July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, and thereafter	\$2,386.00

B. Plenary retail distribution license:

Period	Fee
July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, and thereafter	\$1,798.00

C. Club license: \$180.

SECTION 2: All other provisions of the Ordinance not inconsistent herewith shall remain the same.
