
Four sections

Soil survey – hydrology analysis – archaeological significance

Baseline surveys and identification of small mammals, birds, amphibians, macroinvertebrates, and insects

Ecological studies – flora analysis and inventories – native plant recommendations including placement habitat design for endangered and general wildlife

Delineate goals and priorities – costs – yearly maintenance schedules
