Fall 2015 Leaf Collection: Message from the Borough of Madison Department of Public Works

The town offers three ways for residents to dispose of their leaves:

Leave containers at the Curb: Weekly curbside collection of yard waste in containers will start March 16, 2015 and continue until December 16, 2015. **We encourage using containers for leaf collection as it is efficient, environmentally friendly and the best option for storm water management. Free leaf bags are available at various municipal offices for Madison residents.**

Bring to Municipal Garage: Residents can bring leaves to the Municipal Garage on weekdays from October 26 to December 4, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. Note, this is weekdays only and no commercial dumping is allowed.

Rake to Curb: Collection will start on October 26 and weather permitting will continue until early December. ****Please get your leaves to the curb as soon as possible. December 4 is the last day to put out your leaves.****

In order to make curbside collection of leaves more efficient, place the leaves in the street. This allows our workforce to use front-end loaders for pickup when leaves are wet. Please call the Department of Public Works at 973-593-3088 if you require any additional information.



Madison Recycles Styrofoam!

Clean styrofoam including large pieces, broken pieces and peanuts can be recycled at Pack, Ship & More, 300 Main Street for recycling. No food containers. For details call 973-443-0100.



Electronic Recycling

Electronic recycling can be dropped off at PC Problems at 50 Main Street during regular business hours. For details call 973-377-7711.



No Curbside TV Disposal

New Jersey law mandates that all TVs must be recycled. TVs should be dropped off at the Public Works garage on John Avenue. For details call 973-593-3088.

You don't need to bundle or bag! You can place all your paper, cardboard and junk mail in a container and place it at the curb.

Garbage, Yard Waste and Household Hazardous Waste

The recycling district and the district used for garbage/yard waste are the same sections of town (except where noted * for garbage).

Garbage

The Borough offers residents three garbage collection options:

1. **Free Regular Curbside Pickup:** Twice a week curbside pickup from May 18 to September 11, once a week curbside pickup the rest of the year.
2. **Traditional Rear Yard Pickup:** Residents can contract to have their garbage taken from behind or along the side of their home for an annual fee of \$120.
3. **NEW Enhanced Rear Yard Pickup:** Year round, twice a week pickup from behind or along the side of a residence for an annual fee of \$200. The pickups will occur on your regular, twice a week schedule, District 1A and 1B on Monday & Thursday, District 2A and 2B on Tuesday & Friday and District 3 on Wednesday & Saturday.

Residents interested in rear yard pickup should contact the hauler, Suburban Disposal, at 973-227-7020. The hauler will directly bill each resident.

- Each container cannot exceed 80 lbs.
- No construction material, TVs, grass, leaves, medical waste or recyclables.
- NO GARBAGE can be put in corrugated cardboard boxes. Corrugated must be recycled.

Proper Packing

All items must be placed at the curb by 7 a.m. on the day of collection but not earlier than 7 p.m. the previous day. All containers must be removed from curbside prior to 8 p.m. on your collection day. If garbage or recyclables are not put out properly, they will not be collected.

Yard Waste Curbside Collection Period - March 16 To December 16

- Place in containers no larger than 30 gallons, or biodegradable paper bags. NO plastic!
- Limited to grass, weeds, leaves, hedge trimmings & tree prunings.
- Containers should have handles, not exceed 80 lbs, and **materials cannot stick out more than 1 foot from the top of the container.**
- Logs and large branches can not be left at the curb. Twigs and branches up to two inches in diameter, may be tied in 4 foot bundles, or put in reusable containers.
- If a holiday occurs on your collection day, pickup will occur on Thursday of that week.



Yard Waste - During Non-Curbside Collection Period

- Yard waste, including Christmas trees, may be brought to the Borough Garage Recycling Center on John Avenue on Saturday, January 10, 2015 and Saturday, February 7, 2015, between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Electronic Recycling

P.C. Problems at 50 Main Street recycles electronic items including computers, VCRs, stereos, fax machines, cell phones, printers and other items. Please call 973-377-7711 for hours and other information. All TV's and computer monitors (with tubes) must be brought to the Madison Recycling Center on John Ave. Drop off days are Monday and Friday 9 am – 11:30 am only. Please leave items in the red container.

Refrigerators, Air Conditioners, Freezers, or White Goods

Special arrangements must be made for pickup of these items. Call 973-593-3088. A charge of \$25 for refrigerators/freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, stoves, washers, dryers, metal sinks, hot water heaters, etc is required. Payment is required in advance. Pickup occurs on Fridays, except on holidays when it will be picked up on a Thursday.

Motor Oil, Tires and Batteries

Motor oil, used tires, and car batteries can be properly disposed of at many local service stations, or through the Morris County Household Hazardous Waste program.

Household Hazardous Waste

The Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority offers two household hazardous waste collection days in eastern Morris County (usually on a Saturday in April and September). The County also has a permanent site located in Flanders with appointments available throughout the year to bring materials there. For information, call the County at 973-829-8006. Some of the materials accepted include pesticides, herbicides, oil based paints/stains, paint thinners, antifreeze, motor oil, transmission/brake fluid and batteries.

District 2B

Recycling & Yard Waste: Tuesdays.
Garbage: Fridays, with extra pickup on Tuesdays from May 18–Sept. 19.

*Recycling & Yard Waste Collection changed to Wednesdays.

District 3

Recycling & Yard Waste: Wednesdays.
Garbage: Wednesdays, with an extra pickup on Saturdays from May 18–Sept. 19.

Borough Recycling Center

Recycling by Madison businesses MUST BE DONE by either using a private hauler, or by bringing the materials at no charge to the Recycling Area at the Madison Borough Garage on John Avenue on Mondays and Fridays between 9 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.

Residents can also bring recycling to the center during these hours. For additional information call 973-593-3088.

How To Recycle

Newspapers and Magazines

Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, catalogs, telephone books and junk mail should either be placed in a container, tied in small bundles, or placed in paper grocery bags. Also, do not place materials in the gutter on rainy days.

Food and Beverage Containers

Glass, aluminum, tin and steel food and beverage containers and plastic soda, milk, water and detergent bottles may be mixed together and should be placed at the curb in a rigid reusable container such as a crate, bucket or garbage can, no more than 50 lbs. in weight or 30 gallons in size, no bags. If you do not use the proper container, it will not be collected.

A Word About Plastics

Plastic items coded ♻ through ♻ can now be recycled. Rinse your food and beverage containers. Remove lids and caps. There is no need to remove labels. Flatten your plastic containers to save space.

Shop Madison and BYOB (Bring Your Own Bag)

The average American uses 500 bags a year. Please make every effort to reduce your use of plastic bags, or to reuse or recycle them at the recycling bins at Stop and Shop.

Weekly Collection

The Suburban Disposal collects recyclables every week. The material you set out at the curbside

will alternate week to week. Commingled bottles and cans one week; newspapers and magazines the next and so on.

Apartment and Condo Locations

To improve recycling at your location, have the manager or appropriate representative can contact the Recycling Coordinator at 973-593-8496.
