



Walk With A Veteran




A private fund raiser to replace the deteriorating blacktop walkway with pavers at the WWI Eagle and the 911 Memorial at James Park is being undertaken by former Mayor Jack Dunne and a group of Madison citizens to recognize the service of those who served in the military.

The theme of the project, endorsed by the Mayor and Council, is "Walk With Us." An appropriate engraving will be placed in the walkway with the following:

"Our footsteps were heard around the world. We are the few of the all who served our nation with honor, pride, and dignity. Please walk with us."

The cost of the project would be offset by the sale of pavers bearing the name of any person who served in the military, living or deceased.

If you are a veteran that lives or has lived in Madison or a Madison resident, past or present, that wishes to honor a veteran relative can do so by sponsoring a paver engraved with that veteran's name to be placed in the walkway.
