

## ORDINANCE 27-2023

### ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING CHAPTER 94 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "ELECTRIC UTILITY" TO AMEND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE ELECTRIC UTILITY DEPARTMENT AND SET FORTH REQUIREMENTS, FEES AND RATES FOR CUSTOMERS WHO FEED ELECTRICITY INTO MADISON'S ELECTRICAL SYSTEM

**WHEREAS**, the Assistant Borough Administrator/CFO has recommended amending the Electric Utility Rules and Regulations in order to update rules for customers who feed electricity into Madison's Electrical System.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The following schedule shall amend Appendix A, Section 3 to Chapter 94.

#### **94-3 Requirements and fees for customers who install a system to generate and feed electricity into Madison's electrical system.**

An electric utility customer who plans to install a generator to produce electricity on the customer side of the meter must comply with Section 6 of the Rules and Regulations of the Electric Utility Department of the Borough of Madison (see Appendix C) and:

**A.**

Apply for service under the self-generation rules, pay the plan review fee of \$500 at the time of application and obtain the proper construction permits. If resubmission of plans is required, customer must pay a fee of \$250 for each subsequent submission of plans.

**B.**

Acknowledge and accept the terms of this schedule and the rules and regulations regarding the interconnection and operation of a self-generation system.

**C.**

~~Pay for the purchase and installation of a special meter that measures both the amount of energy provided by the Borough and the amount of energy provided by the customer.~~

**D.**

Enter into an interconnection agreement with the Borough of Madison as provided in Section 6 of the Rules and Regulations of the Electric Utility Department of the Borough of Madison (see Appendix C).

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
