### **I. General Updates**

- a. Vanessa Morgenthaler has left the school district for other opportunities
- b. Welcome Victoria Bukey to the alliance
  - i. To be a voting member of the alliance Vicky must complete and submit the Citizen Leadership; needs to be made present at the next council meeting. Sarah will send the form via email
- c. Approval of May 2022 Minutes
  - i. Libby M. and Christine M. approved during the meeting.
  - ii. Victoria B. abstained
  - iii. Not approved at present due to lack of quorum.
- d. FY 2022 (July '21 – June '22):
  - i. Quarterly reports and other reimbursement documents were completed and submitted to County Coordinator
  - ii. Farmers Market tabling – did not coordinate any during the summer due to time constraints. Pick up and start again possible with help from other alliance members
- b. Mary Willis Funari – if interesting in having as a speaker, reading/discussing her book *Real-Time Parenting* may be useful. Reach out to Sarah if interested.

### **II. FY 2023 Funding and Action Plan**

- a. GCADA funding: approved for reimbursement of \$6610.00
  - i. With cash-match, total spending budget comes to **\$8262.50**
- b. Components of GCADA action plan:
  - i. Branding Campaign (\$1000): 2 tabling events and Red Ribbon Week giveaways
    - Group suggested drawstring bags, red ribbon, stickers, bracelets, etc.
  - ii. Community Education (\$4750):
    - Mental Health First Aid training for adults & Youth-Mental Health First Aid training for adults
    - 10 community members for each training
    - Either implement one during Fall '22 and one during Spring '23 **OR** both during Spring '23
  - iii. Parent Education (\$625): Tricia Baker Coming Up for AIR at middle school

- iv. WISE program (\$1887.50):
  - Replacing WISE with CDSMP: Chronic Disease Self-Management Program; discussed with County Coordinator and got approval
  - Partnering with MACC (Chatham); 2 instructors: Sarah Jacob and Amy Lewis.
  - Open to both Madison and Chatham; 12-15 participants per session; to be implemented during October-November. Six sessions of 2.5 hrs.
- c. DMHAS funding for Youth Leadership Program
  - i. 3 year grant; **\$3900** per year; no cash match requirement
    - Year 1: 7/1/22 – 3/14/23 (3 quarters): tMHFA instructor training for 2 candidates – Sarah Jacob & Dina Pressel – goal is to them implement tMHFA among 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders through MCC student group for teaching the curriculum
    - Year 2: 7/1/23 – 6/30/24 (4 quarters): sending high school students to Lindsey Meyer Teen Institute summer program
    - Year 3: 7/1/24 – 9/30/25 (5 quarters): not sure yet.
- d. Supplemental Funding of \$2000
  - i. With 50% cash match, total spending budget comes to **\$3000**; must be expended by 12/2022
  - ii. tMHFA instructor training for 1 more candidate – Allison Bardon from Madison Chatham Coalition
  - iii. cost per instructor training: \$1700; all three tMHFA potential instructors enrolled for 9/28/22-9/30/22 training
- e. Other
  - i. Madison High School Homecoming Dance
    - Possible September 30<sup>th</sup> 9-12pm
    - Any MAASA contribution? Christine to reach out and inquire
  - ii. Madison contribution to summer musicians – opportunities for healthy entertainment or family/ community gatherings?
