## **ORDINANCE 32-2005**

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$24,000.00 TO PURCHASE EMERGENCY LIGHTING FOR POLICE VEHICLES FOR THE MADISON POLICE DEPARTMENT

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Chief of Police has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$24,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of emergency lighting for police vehicles; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$24,000.00 for this purpose; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$24,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of emergency lighting for police vehicles.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$24,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of emergency lighting for police vehicles.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
