

ORDINANCE 2-2004

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$81,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR PURCHASE OF BOMBARDIER FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Public Works Superintendent has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$81,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase a Bombardier to replace the 1988 Bombardier used by the Public Works Department, which is overdue for replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$81,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$81,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a Bombardier for the Public Works Department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$81,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a Bombardier for the Public Works Department.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
