

ORDINANCE 20-2004

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$36,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR CLEAN UP OF BOROUGH PROPERTY LOCATED AT BLOCK 4312, LOTS 14, 15 AND 16, COMMONLY KNOWN AS 22 ORCHARD STREET

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$36,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for clean up of Borough property located at Block 4312, Lots 14, 15 and 16, commonly known as 22 Orchard Street, to include Phase I investigation, fencing, surface cleanup and Phase 2 investigation; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$36,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$36,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for clean up as described above of Borough property located at Block 4312, Lots 14, 15 and 16, commonly known as 22 Orchard Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$36,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for clean up of Borough property located at Block 4312, Lots 14, 15 and 16, commonly known as 22 Orchard Street to include Phase I investigation, fencing, surface cleanup and Phase 2 investigation.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
