

## ORDINANCE 28-2003

### ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$10,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEM FOR THE POLICE COMMUNICATIONS DESK

**WHEREAS**, the Police Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$10,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase and installation of an air conditioning system to replace the non-functioning system currently at the police communications desk; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$10,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for this purpose.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The amount of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase and installation of an air conditioning system for the police communications desk.

**SECTION 2:** The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
