

ORDINANCE 31 - 2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON FIXING SALARIES AND WAGES FOR POSITIONS REPRESENTED BY FIREMEN'S MUTUAL BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION LOCAL NO. 74

WHEREAS, all full-time paid Captains and paid Firefighters of the Madison Fire Department are represented for the purpose of collective bargaining by the Firemen's Mutual Benevolent Association Local No. 74 (hereinafter "FMBA"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough and the FMBA reached agreement on wages, salaries and benefits for a new collective bargaining agreement which shall be effective January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2005;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The attached wage schedule for job classifications with progression schedules for employees represented by the FMBA, incorporated herein by reference, is hereby established for the years 2003, 2004 and 2005.

Section 2. This ordinance repeals all previous ordinances pertaining to positions and salaries relative to employees represented by the FMBA.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
