

ORDINANCE 21-2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$24,500.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF A NEW CODE ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE FOR USE BY CODE ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$24,500.00 for the purchase of a new code enforcement vehicle for use by the Building Code Enforcement personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has certified that the current code enforcement vehicle is a 1996 sedan and is fully depreciated; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$24,500.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$24,500.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a new code enforcement vehicle; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$24,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a new code enforcement vehicle.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
