

**ORDINANCE 15 – 2002**

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING CHAPTER 30 OF THE MADISON BOROUGH CODE TO CLARIFY ACCUMULATION OF SICK AND VACATION LEAVE TIME**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Administrator has recommended that Chapter 30 of the Madison Borough Code entitled "Personnel Policies" be amended to clarify the accumulation of sick and vacation leave time; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that Chapter 30 of Madison Borough Code should be amended in order to make this clarification.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 30 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Madison entitled "Personnel Policies" is hereby amended to provide as follows:

**§ 30-15. Vacation leave. . . .**

O. An employee absent from work for more than 90 consecutive workdays for any reason shall not continue to accumulate vacation leave time until that employee returns to work.

**§ 30-16. Absences due to illness or disability.**

(6). An employee absent from work for more than 90 consecutive workdays for any reason shall not continue to accumulate sick leave time until that employee returns to work.
