ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$42,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING AND DESIGN SERVICES FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO GARFIELD AVENUE

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough award a professional services contract for engineering and design services in regard to the improvement of Garfield Avenue in preparation of the 2005 Road Improvements Program; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$42,000.00 for this purpose; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$42,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for a professional services contract for engineering and design services in regard to the improvement of Garfield Avenue in preparation of the 2005 Road Improvements Program; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$42,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for a professional services contract for engineering and design services in regard to the improvement of Garfield Avenue in preparation of the 2005 Road Improvements Program.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
