ORDINANCE 24-2002

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$25,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADE AND REPAIRS

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Madison Police Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$25,000.00 for the repair and upgrade of the traffic signals located in the Borough; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 for this purpose; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$25,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the repair and upgrade of the traffic signals located in the Borough.

. <u>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED</u> by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$25,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the repair and upgrade of the traffic signals located in the Borough.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
