ORDINANCE 7-2009

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$84,663.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING, SURVEY AND FENCE AT 22 ORCHARD STREET, BLOCK 4312, LOTS 14, 15 AND 16

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$84,663.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for a survey, fence installation, and site remediation investigation at the Borough-owned property at Block 4312, Lots 14, 15 and 16, known as the Orchard Street Property; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$84,663.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$84,663.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for a survey, fence installation, and site remediation investigation at the Borough-owned property at Block 4312, Lots 14, 15 and 16, known as the Orchard Street Property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$84,663.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for a survey, fence installation, and site remediation investigation at the Borough-owned property at Block 4312, Lots 14, 15 and 16, known as the Orchard Street Property.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
