ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$7,000.00 FROM THE ELECTRIC CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR PURCHASE OF TWO HYDRAULIC LIFT TAILGATES FOR PICK-UP TRUCKS 136 & 137

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Electric Utility Superintendent has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$7,000.00 from the Electric Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase and installation of two hydraulic lift tailgates for pick-up trucks 136 and 137; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the Electric Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$7,000.00 for this purpose; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$7,000.00 from the Electric Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase and installation of two hydraulic lift tailgates for pick-up trucks 136 and 137.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$7,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Electric Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase and installation of two hydraulic lift tailgates for pick-up trucks 136 and 137.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.
