ORDINANCE 31-2015

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING CHAPTER 166 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "STREETS AND SIDEWALKS" TO REDUCE SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT PERMIT FEES

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough amend the Borough Code to provide for an annual program of reimbursement to residential property owners for a portion of the cost of replacement or installation of sidewalks on land abutting a public street; and

WHEREAS the Borough Engineer recommends that permit fees and bond requirements be relaxed for residential applicants to encourage participation in the sidewalk reimbursement program; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council concurs in this recommendation to improve the conditions of sidewalks in the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, County of Morris, State of New Jersey that:

SECTION 1: Chapter166 of the Borough Code, entitled "Streets and Sidewalks" is amended to include the following:

§ 166-25. Sidewalk Opening Permits: Specification; Inspections.

B. Upon submission of the Sidewalk Permit Application, the Borough Engineer may reduce the permit application fee to the nominal amount of \$50.00 for residential applicants falling under the Municipal Partial Reimbursement Program § 166-34, and reduce or waive performance deposit requirements where residential applicants can demonstrate no adverse impact to adjoining public curbs, pavements or public structures resulting from the proposed sidewalk improvement.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
